Audition Requirements:

1. Solo of applicant's choice. (*No more than 3 minutes. Please include the main expository or main thematic section from either the first or final movement.*)

2. Excerpts:

Beethoven: Symphony No. 5 – Movement III, Trio

Berlioz: Symphonie Fantastique – Movement II, Beginning to Rehearsal “22” AND
Movement IV, Rehearsal “50” to Rehearsal “53”

Mozart: Symphony No. 39 – Movement IV, Pickup to mm. 105-137

Rimsky-Korsakov: Scheherazade – Movement IV, *Più stretto* after Rehearsal “V” to Rehearsal “W”

Tchaikovsky: Symphony No. 4 – Movement I, Rehearsal “P” to 1 measure after Rehearsal “Q”

You may audition for the JCSO in one of two ways:

1. Record a video of the audition requirements above and place your video on YouTube, Vimeo, or in Dropbox and share the link with pm@jcsymphony.com. Video submissions should not be password protected and must be received by September 8, 2022 to receive consideration for full season employment. You may submit a video after this date to be considered for performances later in the season.

2. Request a live audition on Thursday, September 8, 2022 at Milligan University (auditions will begin at 5:00 p.m.) by calling or emailing the audition contact below.

Both methods of audition submission will receive equal consideration by the audition committee.
