Audition Requirements:

1. Solo of applicant's choice. (*No more than 3 minutes. Please include the main expository or main thematic section from either the first or final movement.*)

2. Excerpts:

Violin (all Violin I parts):

Beethoven: Symphony No. 9 – Movement III, mm. 99-114

Brahms: Symphony No. 2 – Movement I, Rehearsal “E” to Rehearsal “F”

Mendelssohn: A Midsummer Night's Dream – Scherzo, 8 measures before Rehearsal “A” to 6 measures after Rehearsal “D”

Mozart: Symphony No. 39 – Movement IV, Beginning to Rehearsal “A”

Tchaikovsky: String Serenade – Movement II, Beginning to Rehearsal “C”

Weber: Der Freischutz Overture – Rehearsal “C” to 5 measures after Rehearsal “F”

You may audition for the JCSO in one of two ways:

2. Request a live audition on Thursday, September 7, 2023 at Milligan University (auditions will begin at 5:00 p.m.) by calling or emailing the audition contact below.

Both methods of audition submission will receive equal consideration by the audition committee.
