Audition Requirements:

1. Solo of applicant's choice. (No more than 3 minutes. Please include the main expository or main thematic section from either the first or final movement.)

2. Excerpts:

Horn (all Horn I parts except where indicated):

Beethoven: *HORN II PART * Symphony No. 3 – Movement III, mm. 171-205 (Trio)

Dvorak: Symphony No. 9 – Movement IV, 8 measures before Rehearsal "11" to Rehearsal "11" Mendelssohn: *HORN IV PART* Symphony No. 3 – Movement II, Pickup to 16 measures after

Rehearsal "A" to Rehearsal "B"

R. Strauss: Till Eulenspiegel – Beginning to Rehearsal "1"

Tchaikovsky: Symphony No. 4 – Movement I, Beginning to 6 measures after Rehearsal "A" AND

Movement I, Rehearsal "I" to Rehearsal "L"

Tchaikovsky: Symphony No. 5 – Movement II, mm. 8-28
